The New Mexico Legislature will begin the 2011 Session on January 18th. NMOHVA expects the upcoming 60-day session will be a busy one as the Legislature grapples with New Mexico's fiscal situation and a myriad of proposed legislation. The state's deficit could, once again, make the OHV Trail Safety Fund an

attractive target for a raid. And the opponents of OHV recreation can be counted on to try some legislative shenanigans to limit your ability to enjoy your OHV's. NMOHVA will be carefully monitoring all the proposed bills and keeping you informed!

What can you do to support OHV recreation during 2011 Legislative Session?

1. **Read NMOHVA's Legislative Updates** - We will, once again, keep our members and friends informed of issues affecting OHV recreation throughout the 60 day session with timely updates. Read the updates and forward them to your family, friends, and riding buddies.
2. **Contact your Legislators** - We have quickly developed a reputation as a group of citizens who cares, DEEPLY and PASSIONATELY, about our sport and the legislation that can affect it. The legislators know you and listen to you. The NMOHVA updates will give you detailed information on who to contact, how to contact them, and what you can tell them. Exercise your right

Rocky Mountain ATV/MC Helps NMOHVA Offer Exciting Membership Incentive

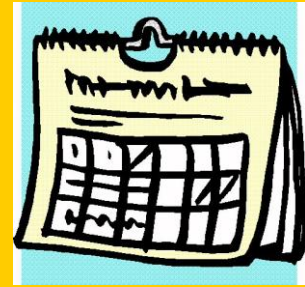
