The function of the Board is to advise the NM Department of Game & Fish on implementing New Mexico's Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Act. Game & Fish decides how to spend the money we pay into the sticker fund. It is critical that OHV users have input into how the money is spent. NMOHVA has been working hard since Governor Martinez took office to get proper OHV representation on the Board. Ron is also a hunter and he will be filling the hunter/angler seat on the Board. Ron is a past NMOHVA board member and founder of the High Country ATV Explorers. Ron is also currently serving as NMOHVA's Trail Ambassador. Congratulations, Ron!

Volunteers Still Needed for Project Work on Cedro Peak Trails

It is not too late to help out on NMOHVA's landmark trail improvement project underway at Cedro Peak in the Sandia Ranger District (Cibola National Forest). Fire restrictions this summer delayed the planned completion date and work on the project continues. The project is funded

with a Recreational Trails Program (RTP) grant obtained by NMOHVA. The Youth Conservation Corp is doing the heaviest work (trail building and repair). We need volunteers for the 'lighter work', including fencing and gates and rehab (painting) some of the facilities at our new OHV trailhead. We are particularly in need of a heavy equipment operator (we will supply the equipment) to do some grading at the new OHV trailhead. The work will take place starting this month and will continue as long as the weather allows.
